Description

Cans For Kids is a registered charity, formed in 1990 to organise the collection and recycling of aluminium cans in Cyprus. To encourage people to save their cans, it was decided to use the proceeds to purchase medical equipment for the children's wards at Cypriot hospitals. Since its inception, more than 16 million cans have been collected, and over £120,000 worth of equipment has been donated to the Makarios Hospital in Nicosia, which is the central paediatric hospital in Cyprus, treating seriously ill children from all over the island. As well as upgrading the equipment - and therefore the standard of care - in Cypriot children's wards, Cans For Kids raises awareness of the benefits of recycling by visiting schools to give talks and show the Cans For Kids video explaining why we should recycle aluminium.

To carry out scientific research in the fields of gender, environment, culture and public health according to universal ethics.

Activities

The organization has cooperated with Environmental Education Centre in an environmental awareness building project. It has carried out fund-raising activities. It has given press releases on the environmental issues. It has acted as a consultant on environmental issues to journalists and its articles has appeared in the press. Is in close cooperation with the press and this year has started publishing weekly articles on environment. Besides environment, CSRS has been active on public health and awareness issues. The first phase of the STD project has recently been completed, which involved research on the status of STD in the Turkish Cypriot Community, as well as identifying risk groups. As a follow-up to this project, a one-day-long conference was organized titled "1st Domestic Conference on Sexually Transmitted Diseases: STD in north Cyprus."

Cooperation

1) Cultural and Scientific Research Society (CSRS), since its establishment, has dedicated itself to efforts in promoting public health awareness and environmental awareness. As part of these efforts, CSRS has carried out numerous educational projects.

2) In 2003, CSRS implemented an environmental awareness-building project in partnership with Environmental Studies Center titled "Learning in the Landscape." 140 students of age groups 15-29 were trained in four summer camps. At the end of the project five handbooks on Environmental Education for teachers were developed.
3) In 2003, CSRS completed Phase I of its STD Project, which involved research on the status of STD in the Turkish Cypriot Community. The five- month project has helped to collect scientific information on the demographics of STD in north Cyprus, and identified STD risk groups, which include high-school students. The results of this project have attracted media attention on STD, as CSRS continues its efforts on STD research and awareness.

4) CSRS organized the "1st Domestic Conference on Sexually Transmitted Diseases: STD in north Cyprus," a oneday conference on STD, STD awareness, STD risk groups, different STD types, contracting and preventing STD, treatment methods, treatment cost and duration, educational efforts, and efforts of GO and NGO's on STD prevention and public health protection. The conference took place on 30 October 2003, with multiple guest speakers, and attracted massive media attention, including newspapers and television stations.

5) The members of CSRS continue training themselves by attending seminars and workshops including the recent WHO training on HIV and AIDS in Cyprus.

6) "Marine Turtles CD Project," was carried out by CSRS. The project produced an educational CD on Marine Turtles.
